

## Emergency Management Minutes, 11/27/2012

Members present: Don Sheldon, George Miller, Martin Halvorsen, Luther Young, Thomas Palmer and John Williams. Guests: Chris Hanson, SHOA budget committee chairman and Bill Neal, Water Superintendent. The proposed equipment budget was discussed. A motion was made to accept the proposal by Lou Young and seconded by Martin Halvorsen. The discussion involved both the issue of the towers. We were assured by Chris Hanson, the SHOA budget committee chairman, that the towers' disposition would remain in our control. There was also concern on achieving the height variance. Chris Hanson and John Williams agreed to meet on Thursday and construct the application for the variance to go to the architectural Committee on Tuesday, December 4. Additional concern was expressed about our present lack of RACES qualified licensed hams, in the event of an emergency declared by the Pacific County Emergency Management Agency. The vote on the motion was 5 in favor, with one abstention (Miller). The motion passed. Martin and John planned to go to the Ham Radio Outlet in Portland to pick up the equipment on Friday, November 30.
