# Waterways are closed to fishing temporarily...

But...

Over the next few weeks, the Surfside Water/Field Services Department crews will be assessing the growth of the fish population along the canal and within the lakes to determine if there is sufficient growth in the various fish species to allow reopening of fishing along and in the Surfside Waterways. Notice of these findings will be provided as soon as they become available and the No Fishing restrictions re-evaluated.



## WORK IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY

At their meeting on January 17, 2009, the Surfside BOT passed a new policy into the Surfside Operations Manual establishing procedures for removal of obstructions in the street rights-of-way or on Surfside owned property and further setting requirements of private homeowners to assess their individual property to determine if any existing improvements or other obstructions need to be removed in conjunction with construction, maintenance or repair projects of the Surfside Water Distribution System and related facilities.

As you know, this year Surfside will begin the water main replacement project, which will involve construction along the frontage of individual properties. Owners need to prepare for this upcoming project by determining the location of their property lines along the streets and confirm that this area is clear of obstructions.

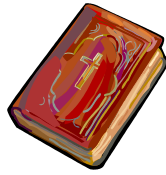
