# Flood Relief

FEMA Registration Open for 60 Days



South Bend, Washington – On January 30, 2009 the registration period opened to register damages with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Every disaster victim needs to call 800-621-FEMA (3362) or visit [www.disasterassistance.gov](http://www.disasterassistance.gov) and register. FEMA registration is only available until March 31, 2009. For face to face assistance you may visit the Disaster Recovery Center (DRC) located at Our Savior's Lutheran Church (basement entrance), 324 Jackson Street in Raymond. You are not required to go to the DRC to register. The hours of operation are

Monday through Saturday, 9:00 AM – 7:00 PM. The DRC will be open until further notice.

Visitors to the DRC will find information on:

- FEMA and State disaster assistance programs
- Small Business Administration low-interest disaster loans and how to complete the loan application
- Smart building techniques to reduce damage from future floods, and
- Flood insurance

*Pacific County was included in a disaster declaration for individual assistance as a result of the early January flooding. If you reported damages to the Pacific County Emergency Management Office during January 9-15, 2009 this **did not** register your household with FEMA. **If you do not register with FEMA you will not get assistance.***

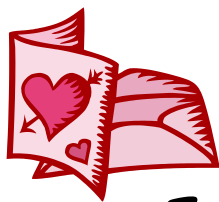

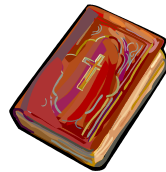
