## BURN RESTRICTIONS CONTINUE:

- Burn restrictions are in effect in Pacific County for forest and yard debris until further notice. Recreational campfires are allowed if built in improved fire pits in designated campgrounds such as those typically found in local, County and state parks, and in commercial campgrounds. On private land, campfires are
  - permitted with the landowner's permission if built in the following manner.
    - In a metal, stone or masonry-lined fire pit, such as those seen in approved campgrounds.
    - Not exceeding three feet in diameter.
    - Have an area at least 10 feet
  - cleared of all flammable material and have at least 30 feet of clearance from overhead fuels (such as tree limbs).
  - Attended at all times by a responsible person at least 16 years old with the ability and tools to extinguish the fire, such as a shovel and either five gallons of water or a connected and charged water hose.

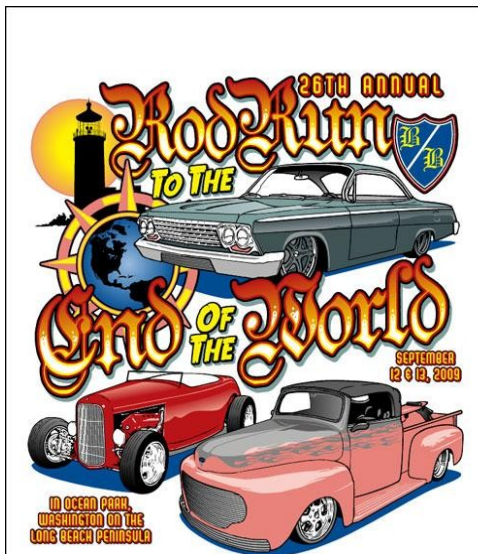
