EXPLORE OCEAN PARK VILLAGE SHARE A BONFIRE AT THE BEACH

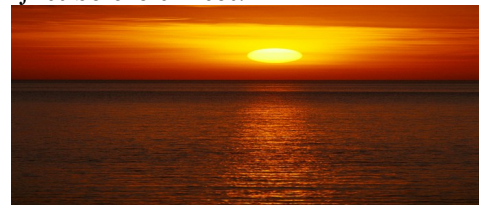
Visit our village and we'll share our sunset! Spend the day shopping, eating and exploring our town.

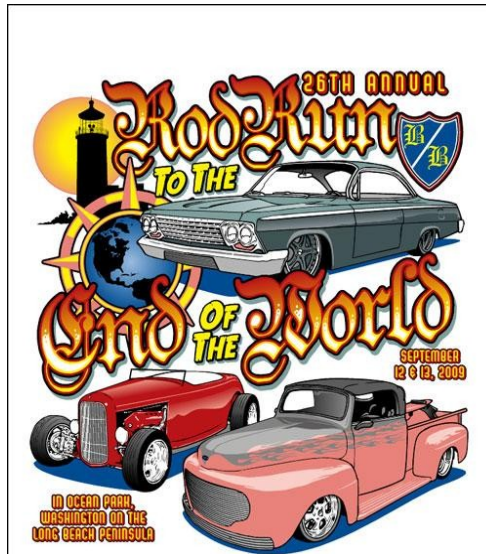

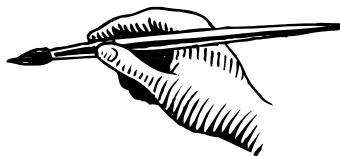
