The Board met Friday to discuss the job description and posting for the General Manager. While the description is lengthy (five pages) three general qualities seemed to receive emphasis:

- Technical skills: Because we deliver water the person should have technical understanding, and because we are about to undertake significant projects, some project management experience would be valuable.
- Financial skills: Creating and living within the budget is important.
- People skills: The general manager needs to be able to lead the staff and volunteers and provide quality customer service to members.

The job will be posted with a salary range of \$55,000 to \$65,000.
