Watch for the mailing of the ratification proxy votes

The Surfside Board of Trustees adopted the 2009 Budget at their meeting on October 18, 2008. Once the Board adopts the budget it must notify members of the adopted budget and they vote to ratify by proxy or in person at a Special Membership Meeting that coincides with the November Board Meeting (November 15, 2008, at the Surfside Board Room). The mailing has been taken to the printers today, 10/23/08, and is expected to be mailed out sometime next week with delivery towards the end of the week. Surfside Christmas Gift Program

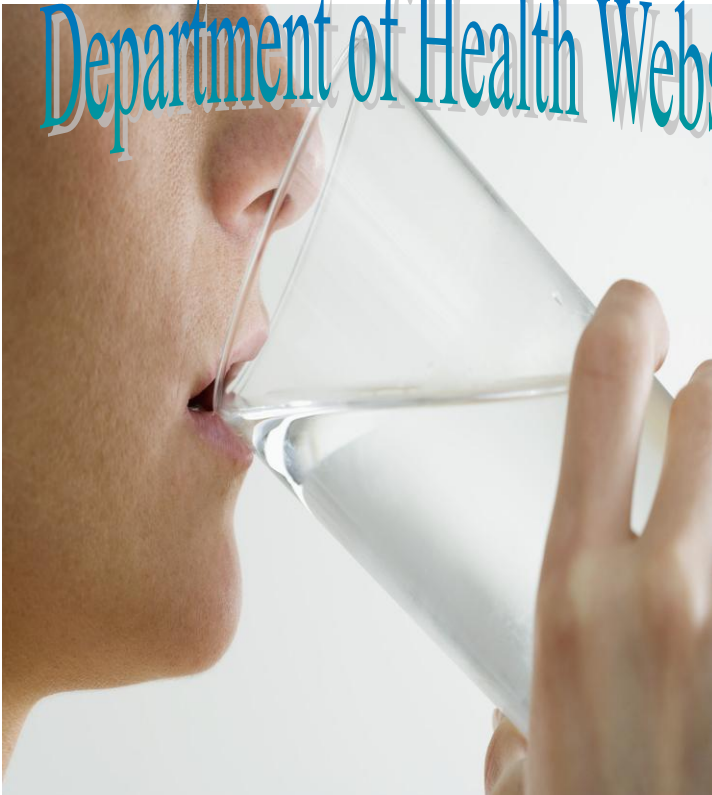

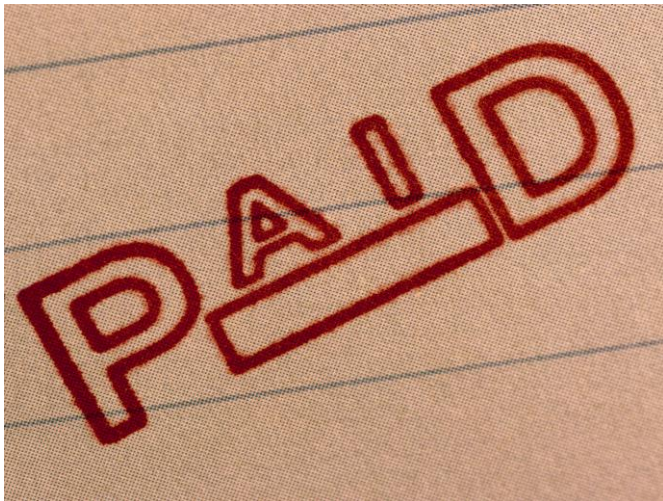

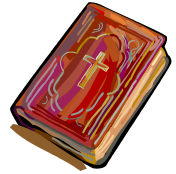
