## **Surfside Homeowners Association Business Office/Community Meeting Room: EMERGENCY USE GUIDELINES**



### **GOAL:**

Provide a friendly, warm environment for surfside community members to come during emergency situations related to severe winter weather conditions and storms that may result in power outages. The community meeting room has the availability of a propane fireplace and generator to assist members in coping with adverse weather conditions and power outages together.

### **FACILITY LOCATION:**

Surfside Homeowners Association Business Office/Community Room – 31402 H Street.

### **HOURS OPEN:**

10:00 A.M. TO 3:00 P.M. - **OPEN TO MEMBERS DAILY DURING THESE HOURS WHEN POWER HAS BEEN OUT MORE THAN 24 HOURS, OR AS DIRECTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.**

### **STAFFING OF FACILITY:**

Staffing of the facility will be a combined effort by the community relations committee, surfside staff & Board members. These members/staff will work in coordination with emergency management committee members and General Manager. Shift timelines will be determined by member/staff availability.

### **DURATION:**

Facility will remain open to members until all power in surfside is restored.

### **FACILITIES AVAILABLE:**

Coffee, water, restrooms, information, heat and electricity (power/lights). No food or lodging will be offered or provided.

***NOTE: Power availability will be limited with generator provided by Surfside.***



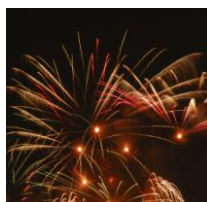
***It is possible that the Weekender could be suspended until after the holiday season...***
