- Ralph will use a fish finder device at bridges that shows water depth and water quality on canal and Seabreeze

Waterways ownership was clarified for our committee. The State owns all water, SHOA members own the land under the water.

- Laura provided a copy of two-year-old owner survey where members decided whether to allow SHOA to clean up their canal property or do the cleanup themselves. It was suggested that we send this survey out again this Spring since it does seem to encourage cleanup.
- Ownership and easements on shorelines was clarified to determine responsibility for cleanup on Twin Lakes, Deer Lake, and Seabreeze.

- John will research viability of other species for our waterways.
