

March Tree, Brush, Noxious Weeds and Vegetation Committee Meeting

Call to Order: March 17, 2017 @ 1:05pm Surfside HOA Business Office

Present: Chairperson Larry Raymer, Al Franklin, Karen Pachman, Peggy Olds, George Miller and Laura Frazier

Compliance Issues: Laura Frazier reported that ten (10) new complaints were added this month and six(6) complaints has been closed after reviewed by Larry Raymer. We now have a total of fifteen (15) complaints remaining. Laura Frazier has sent out an initial 8 letters to members as well as 1 second notice, 2 warning letters and 4 fine letters. Laura has sent a letter to a member and reported to Pacific County concerning Gorse on property. Jeff Nesbitt from the County will add to his inspections and contact the member.

Charter Change: Rick Hunting will present the proposed charter Change at tomorrows (March 18) Board meeting

Other Comments: Larry Raymer, Al Franklin and another Friend (name not given) drove throughout Surfside and reported that they counted 300 properties that had noxious weeds present. He also reported that 75 lots had slash. (FYI: to date we have only one reported complaint concerning Gorse from 1/14/17 and one complaint concerning Yellow flag Iris in canal from 7/7/16. This property owner is waiting until Spring when the plant is in bloom to remove.)

Larry asked for a discussion concerning the upcoming Chipper Site and FireWise Program. He feels that Surfside is not in compliance with County Ordinances #2 and #4. He believes the large pile of debris at the chipper site is a fire hazard. Committee feedback to Larry: it was a very popular program for Surfside members and that should discuss his concerns and possible solutions with the other Board members involved, especially Chris Hanson, who chairs the FireWise efforts for Surfside.
