

# Minutes for the Emergency Management Committee for March 27, 2018

The meeting came to order at 1 PM. It adjourned at 2:53 PM.

1. John Williams and Al Franklin attended the Architectural Committee in the morning. The upshot is that we need to do a new plot Plan for next week.
2. John Williams met with Linda Dwyer also in the morning, she lives in the house that is next to the site at the Water Department. She indicated that the proposed site was acceptable to her.
3. The committee passed this motion: Build a 10'X12' shed at the site at the Water Department in the NW corner by the driveway and build any additional sheds at sites to be determined as future demands require them.
4. A motion was made to approve a request from Pete Riedel to do a presentation on emergency shelter pods. The motion was passed.
5. We are scheduling our next tsunami run for Saturday, July 7. The tentative course is from Skating Lake to the Emergency Assembly Area by the golf course and Surfside Inn. We need to contact Community Relations, our Deputy, The OP Fire Department, the golf course and the Surfside Inn.
6. We have a 5<sup>th</sup> Saturday ham exercise scheduled from 9:30 AM to 12 AM this Saturday.
7. John Williams met with Gil Gonzales after the meeting to go over the emergency shed site. The ground will be prepared in April.
8. The next emergency management committee scheduled meeting will be April 24 at 1 PM. We will likely have a special meeting to approve a bid on the shed before then.
