RV SAFETY AT THE BEACH

Common activities associated with motor homes and RVs can cause a hazard to your private and public water system. These hazardous activities are often recommended by the RV manufacturer, RV dealership, RV supply store, or the internet.

Attaching or inserting a water or garden hose to your RV septic blackwater tank, greywater tank, or toilet, can backflow hazardous waste into your private water system and the public water system. Connections between septic and potable water are prohibited by the Uniform Plumbing Code and are prohibited in Surfside by resolution 2013-08-01 (WAC 246-290-490).

Surfside performs safety inspections for compliance. Non-compliance may result in mandatory installation of a Reduced Pressure Backflow Assembly at the meter.
