

# Minutes for the Emergency Management Committee July 31, 2018

1. Update on Emergency Cache Shed. Volunteers in the construction of the shed: Scott Winegar, Al Franklin, Allen Gifford, Fred deLeest, Paul Hoffman, and Mark Scott. Volunteers in painting the shed: Al Franklin, Allen Gifford, and John Williams. Additional painting has been volunteered to by Louise Purdin, Terry Daniels and Jan Jenkins, After the remaining agenda items were addressed, we went to view the shed.

2. Proposed Budget:

3. Review of Tsunami Run: The participation in the tsunami run was disappointing. Several issues were involved First, the run was scheduled at exactly the same time as the Firecracker run in Long Beach. At least one person who had agreed to participate in our run was defending his title in the Firecracker run. The difficulty of locating the Skating Lake cabana kept one paid participant from running. It makes more sense to have the race start on the beach side, where people would more likely be evacuating from a tsunami. We will try to iron out these issues for next year. A couple of suggestions were made regarding the date of the tsunami run, including the Saturday after the annual meeting (July 15), and the Saturday prior to the Kite Festival ( in August). The date will addressed at a future meeting.
