Meeting was called to order at 1:00 P.M.

1. Watershed Company environmental survey

A conference call with Sarah Sandstrom from Watershed Company opened our meeting. Plans were made to meet with Logan McClish next Friday, November 16 at 10:00 A.M. Mr. McClish is the engineer who will be conducting our survey. Ralph, Judy, and Gil will accompany him for his initial inspection. We will also make sure we have our SHOA boat available if needed. The Watershed Co. goal is to have an initial draft of the survey back to us before year's end.

2. Seabreeze Lake survey

Larry clarified that the survey plan has been tabled, not disapproved.

3. Bear Lake fish stocking

Ralph shared the report received from Lauren Bauernschmidt, our Washington Dept of Fish and Wildlife Habitat Biologist for Pacific County. She approved the stocking of trout in Bear Lake with stipulations regarding proper screening of the culvert and outfall. We discussed the best approach to designing and installing proper screens and the platforms necessary to maintain them. We came up with an initial idea that Larry will present at next week's County Flood Control Board meeting, since County guidelines and approval will be the next step in this process. Larry will also inform the Flood Control Board of our survey being done by Watershed.

4. Outfall map

Ralph shared the progress on the outfall map project, and we discussed best methods for proceeding. This map will be a resource for identifying outfall locations. It was suggested that we contact Mark Scott for assistance in the final organizing and assembly of the map.
