Water Use Questionnaires for 2019

Water Use Questionnaires (WUQ) protect your drinking water. These forms provide the water department with information needed to assess the actual or potential risk that contaminated water could be forced or siphoned into your drinking water.

If cross-connection seems bureaucratic and farfetched, just 6 months ago in Waco, Texas consumers complained of bloodworms in their drinking water (bloodworms are not known to be harmful). According to experts, a backflow event with an irrigation system could have been the cause.

Water Use Questionnaires are required to be submitted by members every 4-5 years. WUQs were originally sent out in 2014 and are due again in 2019. If you recently filled out a WUQ, we apologize for the inconvenience but, please fill out the new 2019 questionnaire.

A questionnaire will be mailed to you shortly. **If you prefer, you may submit one online at www.surfsideonline.org/. The online version should be available in a few days.** Questionnaires must be filled out for EACH lot that uses or has access to Surfside water.
