

NOTICE OF CONSERVATION POLICY LIMITS LOWERED

On October 20th, 2018, at the Regular Board Meeting, the Board of Trustees passed Resolution 2018-10-02, authorizing lowering the conservation policy limit from 10,000 cubic feet (74,800 gallons) per month to **8,000 cubic feet** (59,840 gallons) per month for individually metered services, and from 7,500 cubic feet (56,100 gallons) per month to **6,500 cubic feet** (48,620 gallons) per month for master metered services.

Individually metered single family residential connections, individually metered multifamily units, and undeveloped properties exceeding 8,000 cubic feet in one metering period (monthly meter reading cycle) will be charged \$0.03 for each cubic foot exceeding 8,000 cubic feet.

Shared (master metered), multifamily residential connections (condominium, duplex, townhouse, etc.) whose water use exceeds an average of 6,500 cubic feet per residential unit in one metering period (monthly meter reading cycle), will be charged \$0.03 for each cubic foot exceeding 6,500 cubic feet.

Beginning January 1st, 2019, a Conservation Charge (Fine) of \$0.03 for each cubic foot exceeding the newly adopted limits will be assessed against members as a fine for water use that is considered excessively disproportionate and wasteful.

NOTICE OF WATER SHUT OFF FEE REMOVED

On October 20th, 2018, at the Regular Board Meeting, the Board of Trustees passed Resolution 2018-10-02, adopting a new rate schedule and removing the water shut off and turn on fee for members during business hours.

Members are encouraged to call the water department to have their water service turned off at the meter if they are going to be away for extended periods of time. Members may also call the water department to have their water service turned back on before they return. Members who take advantage of this service may prevent costly and wasteful leaks.

Charges still apply for water shut off and turn on services after normal business hours.
