

BOIL WATER NOTICE

Due to a water main break resulting in a loss of system pressure in, Surfside Homeowners Association Water System Department is issuing this precautionary Boil Water Notice.

BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING

Bring tap water to a rolling boil, boil for one minute, and cool before using.
Or use bottled water [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, washing dishes, brushing teeth, and preparing food until further notice.

This Boil Water Notice applies to All customers of Surfside HOA Water.

What Happened ?

At about 1:45 pm on May 21, 2019 the water system lost pressure

due to a Contractor working without proper locates. When water mains lose pressure it increases the chance that untreated water and harmful microbes can enter your water.

Harmful microbes in drinking water can cause diarrhea, cramps, nausea, headaches, or other symptoms and may pose a special health risk for infants, some elderly, and people with severely compromised immune systems. But these symptoms are not just caused by microbes in drinking water. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you should seek medical advice.

What is being done ?

The Water main is being repaired, disinfected, flushed, and sampled for coliform bacteria

It is likely that you will need to boil water for the next 24 to 48 hours until the problem is fixed, and the water passes a coliform bacteria test. You will be informed when tests show that you no longer need to boil your water.
