2026 BUDGET RATIFICATION RESULTS

As announced last week, the 2026 budget passed with 330 votes for (yes) and 148 votes against (no).

The statements for 2026 dues and assessments will be mailed before the end of November. If you do not receive a statement by year's end, please call the office.

Payment is due in full by January 1st, 2026.

Membership Dues for 2026 stay the same at \$100 per member. 2026 assessments are \$674 per lot.

If you own 1 lot, your 2026 annual dues and assessments are \$774. If you own 2 lots, your 2026 annual dues and assessments are \$1,448 (\$100 + \$674 + \$674).

Payments can be made on your AMS portal, and you are always welcome to pay at the HOA office by check, cash or Credit Card.

There is information circulation on Facebook about dead birds found on local beaches. At this time, Pacific County Health & Human Services (PCHHS) has not received confirmation of Avian Influenza (bird flu) related to these reports.

If Avian Influenza is confirmed, PCHHS will be the authority having jurisdiction, and PCEMA will provide support as needed.

If you would like to report dead wild birds, please contact the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife through their reporting line.

We will share additional verified information as soon as it becomes available. Thank you for helping keep our community informed and safe.



ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Plan on installing a fence, a shed, a gazebo or building a garage or a house?

REMINDER...

ALL building plans must be submitted to the Architectural Committee <u>prior</u> to any construction.

Pacific County will not approve permitting until the committee has signed off on all plans.

The committee meets every Tuesdays at 9 a.m. at the business office. The plans MUST be submitted by Friday at noon to be added to the next week's agenda. The building packets are on our website at surfsideonline.org/forms/ or you can pick them up from the business office.

Please notify the business office if you want to attend the meeting in person.

If you are building on a vacant lot without an address, please post a sign so the committee knows which lot will be developed.

Two (2) sets of plot plans must be submitted to the committee. Once approved, you will get a copy of the approved plan. Take it to the county for their approval as needed. Surfside will retain one set of approved plans to keep on file.

For more detailed information on the Architectural Committee duties and guidelines go to our website <u>surfsideonline.org</u>, select the Other tab, then Governing Documents. Download the Operations Manual and the Surfside Restrictive Covenants or call the business office 360-665-4171 with questions.
